This Organization strives to achieve its target through a three pronged strategy:-

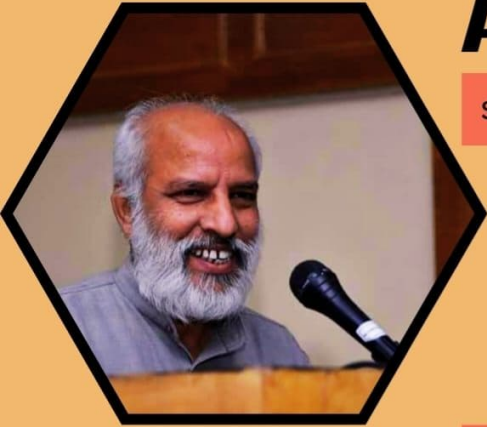

Resumption of Physical Events

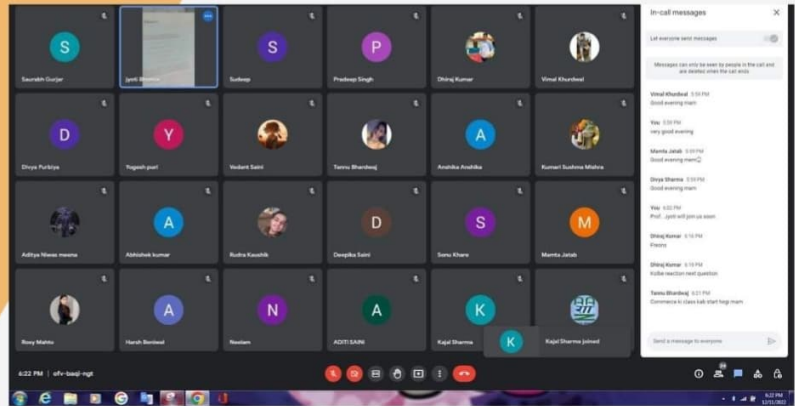
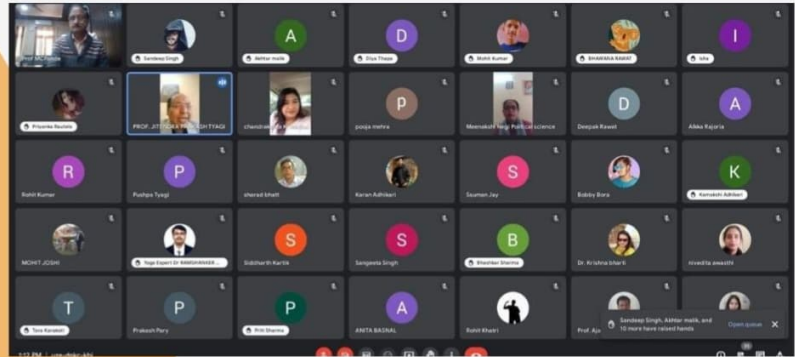
- AAGAZ resumed physical events, marking a significant milestone in its mission despite ongoing challenges.


Free Online Classes for CUET Preparation

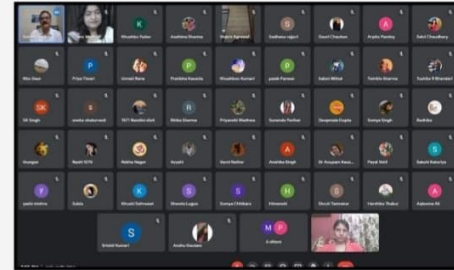

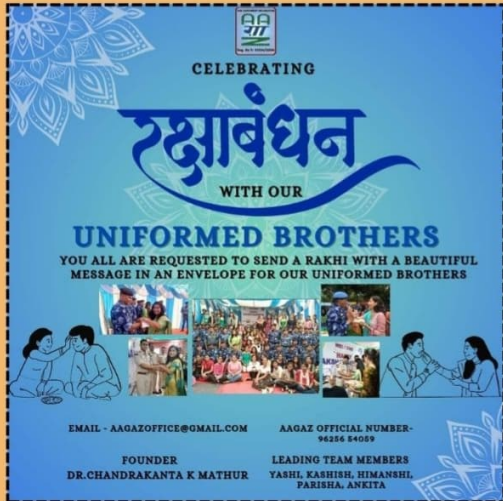


Donation Drive
